

# Manual Lymph Drainage for Massage Therapists\*

Meet the increasing demand for lymphatic work with this 4 day, 40 hour intensive class that offers certification in Manual Lymph Drainage, a manual therapy technique that encourages the free flow of lymphatic fluid in the body. This powerful modality can be used to promote wound healing and injury recovery, reduce swelling, for detoxification and to promote lymphatic recovery after surgery or other trauma.

Each participant will be trained in the basic anatomy and physiology of the lymph system and will learn the manual techniques of Manual Lymph Drainage (MLD). Upon completion of the class, the therapist will be able to successfully perform the techniques, differentiate between varieties of edema, and understand the application, medical indications and contraindications for MLD. The therapist will be able to establish an MLD treatment plan for individual clients.

*Although introductory information about lymphedema and complete decongestive therapy will be included in this course, this is not a lymphedema therapy certification.*
